Enhance your surgical skills and experience by attending the Stanmore Technical AMPutation course, a cadaveric technical surgical skills amputation course, run by Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, Stanmore.

The course is tailored specifically for Surgical Trainees (Trauma and Orthopaedic surgery, Vascular surgery and Plastic surgery trainees ST3 – ST8), this focused course provides hands on experience in performing major lower limb amputations on cadaveric specimens under the supervision of leading consultants in the field of Sarcoma and Trauma. The course provides unparalleled opportunity to develop and refine surgical skills in a practical setting, with one cadaveric specimen allocated between just two participants to maximise learning and operative time.

Participants will gain in-depth knowledge of surgical approaches, anatomical considerations, flap techniques and stump optimisation.

Ideal for trainees seeking to build confidence and competence in this essential but often under taught area to ensure safe future practice as a day one consultant.
